INTRODUCTION TO INTEGRATED KABBALISTIC HEALING

In this workshop participants will be given a hands-on introduction to the theory and practice of Integrated Kabbalistic Healing (IKH). This modality, created by modern kabbalist and dharma teacher Jason Shulman, integrates thirteenth-century Kabbalistic wisdom, the latest theories in quantum physics, and twentieth-century psychological insight and teachings of nonduality, into a deeply transformative healing path. The profound insights of this path are equally valuable for those in the healing arts, such as psychotherapists, energy healers, nurses, chiropractors and doctors, as well as for those in other careers, such as artists, corporate executives, lawyers and teachers, encouraging healing in the world in all walks of life.

Jason Shulman, founder of A Society of Souls, will give an introduction the morning of the workshop and will join Brenda in the afternoon for questions and answers about IKH and the work of A Society of Souls.
